Practice Policies

You are expected to practice at least the same about of time as your lesson EVERYDAY

Outline of what your practice should look like:

1. Scale

- either a scale we've worked on together or a new one
- do not use vibrato to maximize the effectiveness of your scale work
- scale is quarter note = 60
- Whole notes
 - o beautiful sound
 - intonation
 - o conscious of bow placement
- Half notes (slurred 2 notes to a bow)
 - Intonation
 - o beautiful sound
- Quarter notes (slurred 4 notes to a bow)
 - o intonation beautiful sound
 - o smooth bow and note changes
- Eighth notes (slurred 4 notes to a bow)
 - Intonation
 - o beautiful sound
 - o continuous bow and connection between notes

2. Etude

- work towards the goal we have discussed in your lesson

3. Repertoire

- work out the sections that we've talked about
- how is your character?
- record yourself using your phone or computer and give yourself feedback
 - o What was good?
 - What is something you can continue working on?
 - What are you concerned about, need help? Mark it and ask at your next lesson.

4. Orchestra Music

- Work out passages that are causing you some trouble
- Passages your orchestra director has assigned
- Your next playing test assignment
